

Photography and Videography

The St. Francis Public Library reserves the right to utilize photos or videos taken at the library, by library staff or their designees, for editorial purposes in printed materials and online.

Attendance at library-sponsored events and classes constitutes consent for the use of these images unless a patron specifically informs staff of an objection to such use. Names will not be used in conjunction with published images without permission.

In order to protect patron privacy and safety, library patrons and visitors may take photographs or videos of the library building and collections, but may not take photographs or videos of library patrons or patron activity without the express consent of the patron (or, in the case of a minor, the consent of a parent/guardian). These activities may not interfere with library operations, the ability of staff to perform their work, or the privacy of the patron.

No photography or videography that is to be used by media outlets or by commercial or non-profit organizations may take place inside the library without the prior consent of the Library Director.
